Dear Neighbor,

First, we'd like to apologize for sending you a letter pertaining to our AES Huntington Beach plant earlier this month. This letter was intended for residents in Huntington Beach, not Long Beach, and was inadvertently misdirected. Thank you for your understanding.

Second, we would like to provide you with an update on the Alamos Energy Center. Construction work is well underway and we're making excellent progress. To date, 1,265 piles have been set and completed. Piles are deep structural supports that consist of heavy concrete posts installed deep in the ground to provide support to the foundations of the buildings and equipment that sit on top of them. Soon we will begin installing the largest of the foundations, which will support the heavier equipment, such as the new gas turbines and generators.

Pouring the concrete for each individual foundation is a continuous process. Once it has begun, the pour must continue until it is complete to avoid hindering the integrity of the concrete in the foundation. To safely and efficiently complete the pours, AES has requested approval from the California Energy Commission for work during extended hours on **Monday, December 11, 2017** starting at **12:00 a.m.** Extended work hours consist of hours worked outside of our normal construction hours of 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday and designated holidays, and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturdays. Any "extended hours" work on this day will only be related to the long concrete pour needed for the large foundations.

Please note, there will be additional days within the next five months when we will need to start concrete pouring in the early morning. We will notify you of days and activity each month when we are closer to the actual work, and can provide you with the specific dates and times.

As always, safety is our number one priority. We will take all reasonable steps to minimize impacts and inconvenience to our neighbors to the extent possible.
